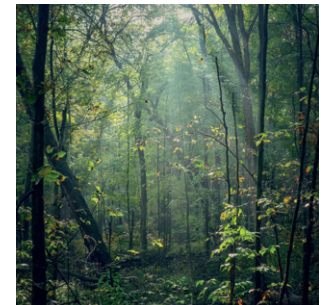


Wood lives and breathes

Like no other material, wood influences our attitude to life and ensures a balanced indoor climate. It can not only balance temperature and humidity, but also filter the air in your own four walls. The potential resulting shrinkage joints and cracks are further proof of the naturalness of the parquet floor.

The power of the sun

Every tree needs sunlight to live and grow. Wood remains a living entity even in the form of a parquet floor, sunlight will continue to influence it, even within your home or workspace. The natural power of the sun can cause discolouration and fading from one timber species to another in varying degrees.

Do's & don'ts

A few simple measures designed to protect your parquet or stairs:



- Stop before you enter. Install adequate barrier matting at the entrance.
- Remove sand, small stones or spillages immediately.
- Install felt pads or suitable plastic casters to the legs/feet of tables and chairs
- Be careful when installing or moving furniture and heavy items
- Fit swivel chairs with standard runners ("W" type)

The correct climate

Humans and wood love the same indoor climate:

- Room temperature: approx. **20°C**
- Relative humidity: this should not fall below **40%** during the **winter months** or rise above **60%** during the **summer months**.

At these levels, people feel most comfortable, and so too does wood which remains stable. To help keep these levels as constant as possible year-round we recommend:

- During the winter months, when heating is necessary, let in short, sharp bursts of fresh air to ensure regular air circulation. However, avoid extended ventilation as this will further reduce low moisture levels and encourage gaps to form.
- During the winter months, when heating is necessary, use additional sources of moisture such as house plants and air humidifiers.

Low energy and passive houses

Controlled room ventilation is important, heat can be recycled and ideally moisture should also be released into the air in a controlled manner. We recommend that measures are taken into consideration and put in place to achieve this, helping to prevent sharp reductions in the air during periods of heating. This will not only benefit your parquet floor but may also benefit your health.

Parquet and underfloor heating

The surface temperature of the parquet floor must not exceed 26°C if being installed over underfloor heating.

Clean parquet floors properly

A regular and effective cleaning/maintenance regime will extend the lifetime of the floor.



We recommend:

- Everyday dirt and dust must be removed using a dry flat headed mop or vacuum cleaner
- Remove sand, small stones or spillages immediately.
- Remove coarse dirt using a well wrung out damp cloth
- DO NOT flood the timber floor with water
- Depending on the surface of the floor, add the Weitzer Parkett recommended cleaning agent to water

Cleaning

Regular cleaning

Application interval: 2-4 times per month

Weitzer Weitzer Parkett are the first and only manufacturer of Maintenance-free parquet, available in ProStrong and ProActive+ surface finishes. Elaborate parquet care is no longer necessary here.

Application

Regular cleaning

Application interval: 2-4 times per month

- Remove dust by sweeping or vacuuming
- Add ProVital Clean & Care to water, then apply using a well wrung out damp mop or cotton cloth
- Repeat the process on heavier soiled areas by hand using a cotton cloth or fine sponge
- Solvent-free – biodegradable



Regular maintenance

Application interval: 2-4 times a year

ProVital Care Spray

- Replenishes and maintains the wear layer
- Refreshes the surface floors and stairs
- Spray a thin layer of ProVital Maintenance Spray onto the cleaned and dried surface, and distribute evenly using a mop or cloth
- Also available to refresh colour pigmentation
- Solvent-free. Based on important ingredients such as carnauba waxes, paraffins and water-repellent additives. Healthy and breathable.



For regular cleaning, you can choose between two special products:

① Weitzer Parkett Pro Vital Clean & Care

This special water-based, solvent-free and pH-neutral product is a highly concentrated, biodegradable neutral cleaner which is manufactured from natural raw materials such as Indian soap nuts and sugar extracts. Allow the floor to dry completely after cleaning with ProVital Clean & Care.

② Weitzer Parkett Cleaning soap

As an alternative to ProVital Clean & Care, you can use this top-quality soap combination. It is produced from natural plant oils, so it's biodegradable and environmentally friendly.



Basic cleaning by the parquet pro:

Application interval: only needed when you are no longer achieving the desired result with regular cleaning and maintenance

- Heavier deposits of dirt can be removed by a timber flooring specialist using a cleaning machine and ProVital Cleaner
- The oil surface can then be built back up with ProVital finish. This renews and refreshes colour tones
- The cleaning and maintenance regime you use on your parquet and stairs helps to develop a wonderful patina thereby enhancing the value and beauty of the timber
